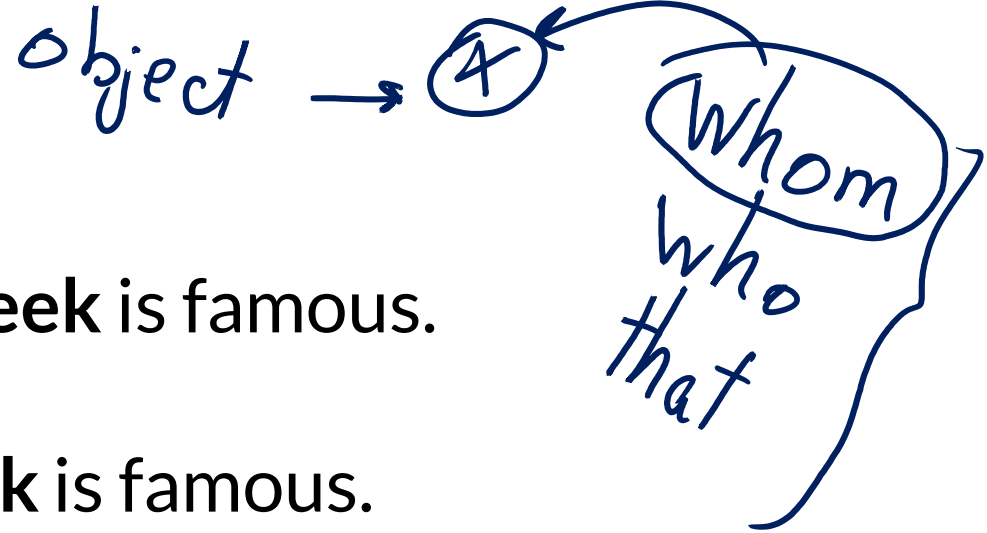

# Relative Clauses

- The boy is famous.
- The boy **whom** you saw last week is famous.
- The boy **who** you saw last week is famous.
- The boy **that** you saw last week is famous.



# Relative Clauses

- The man **whom** you called was a police officer.
- The man **whom** we met was my English teacher.
- The police found the boy **whom** we saw.
